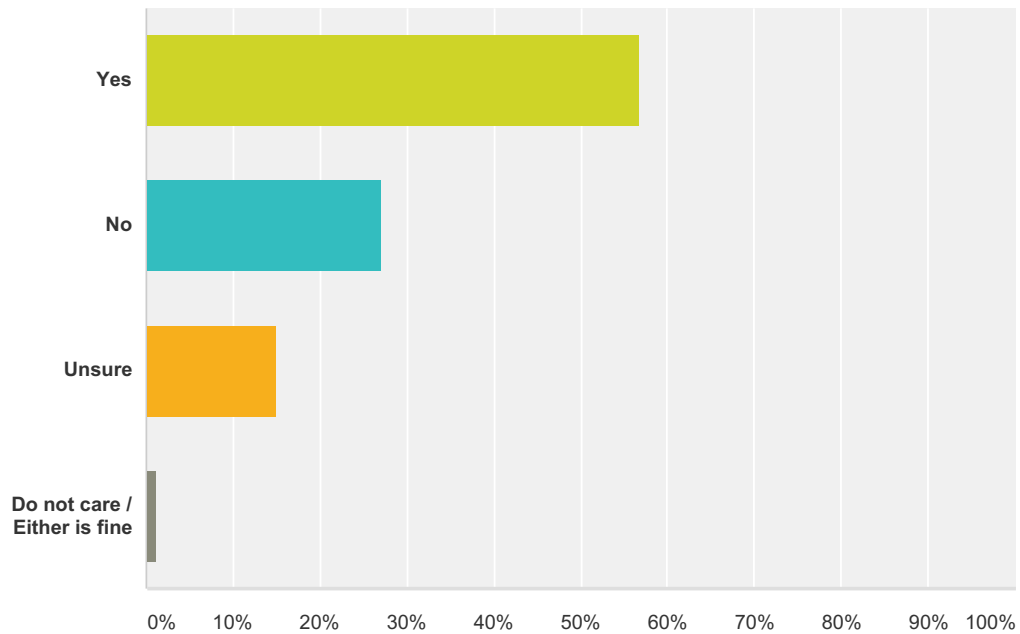


Political Attitudes Survey

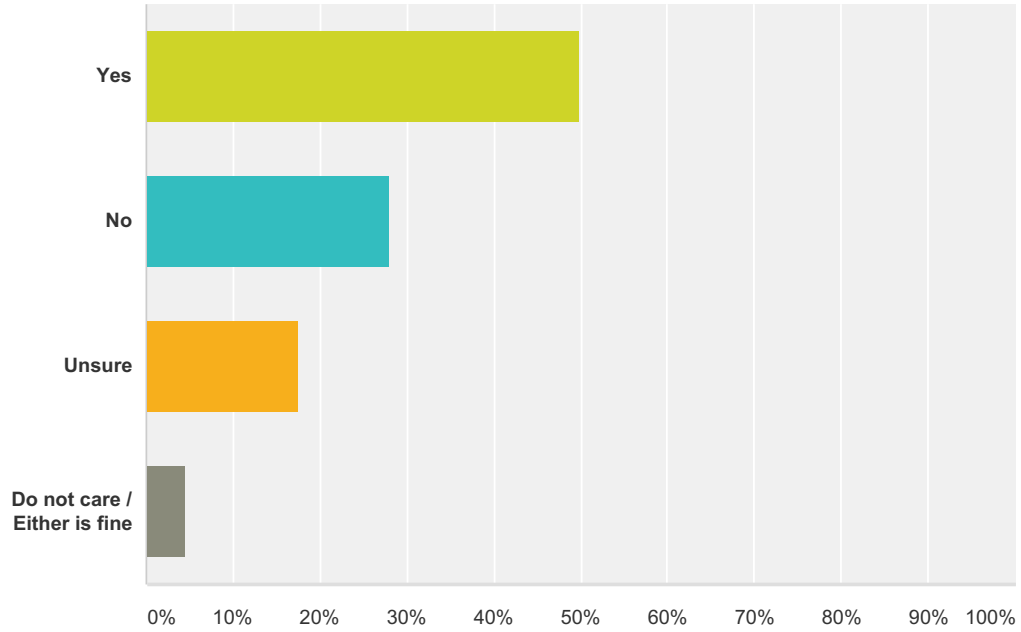

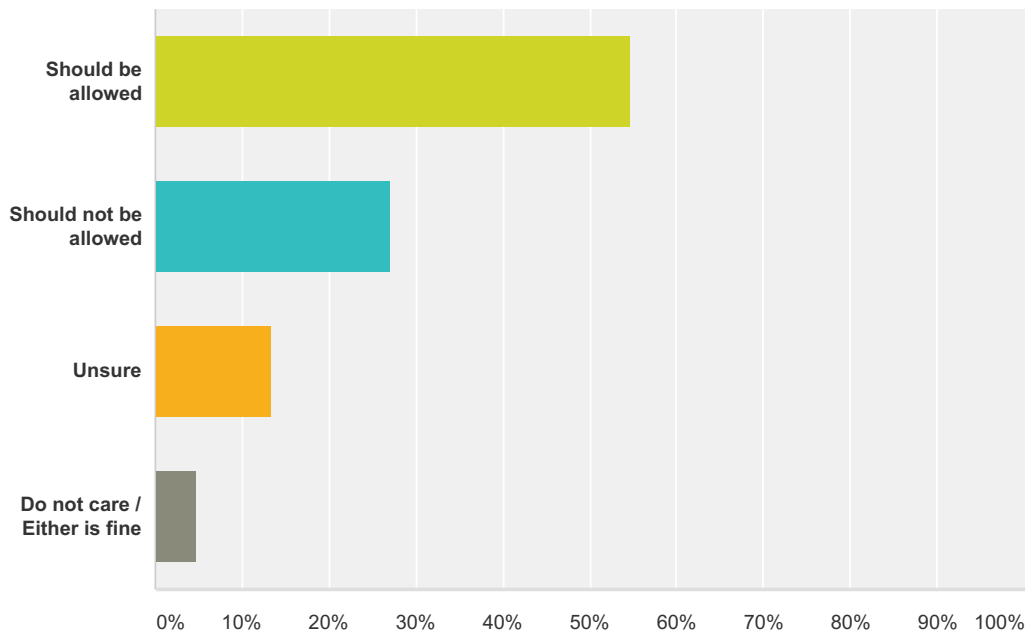

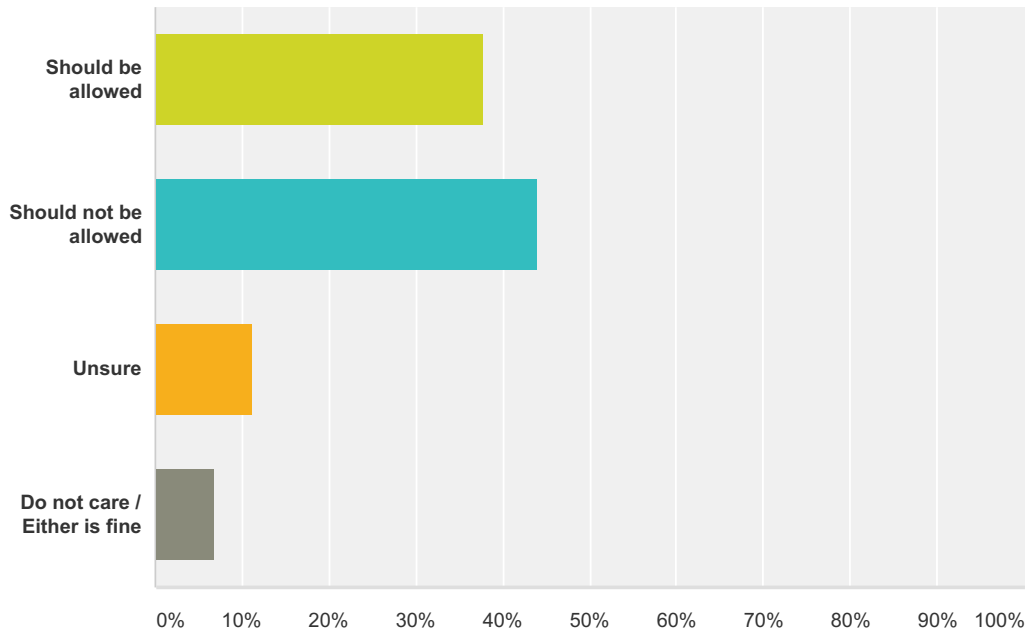

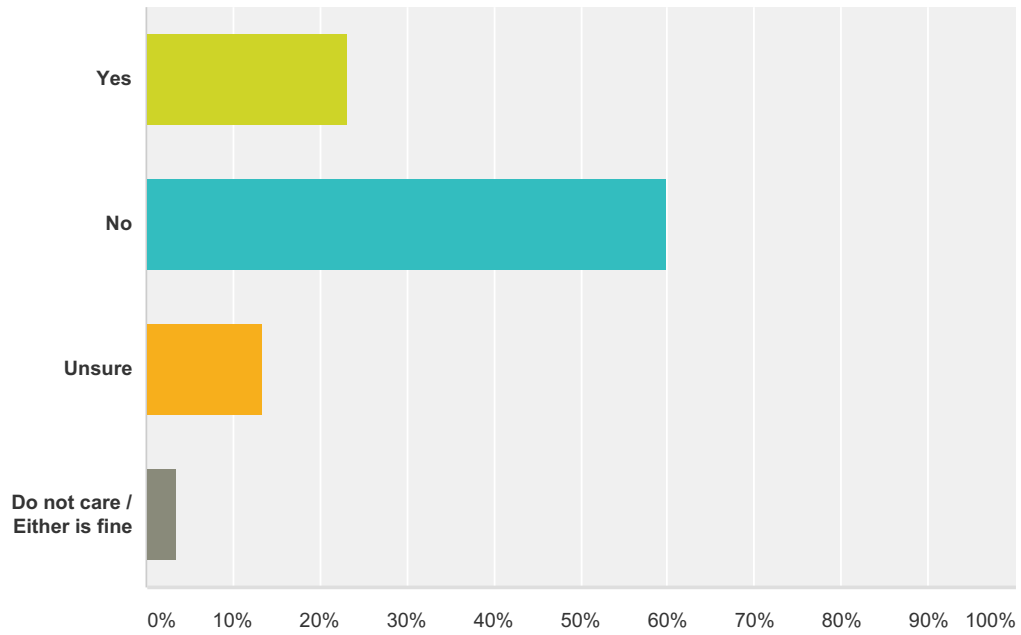

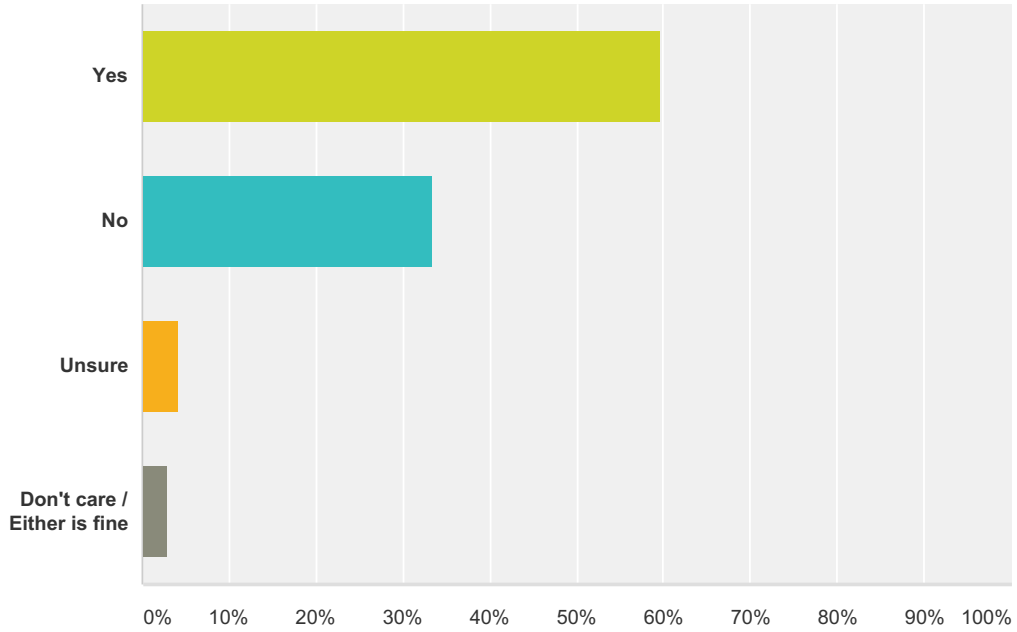

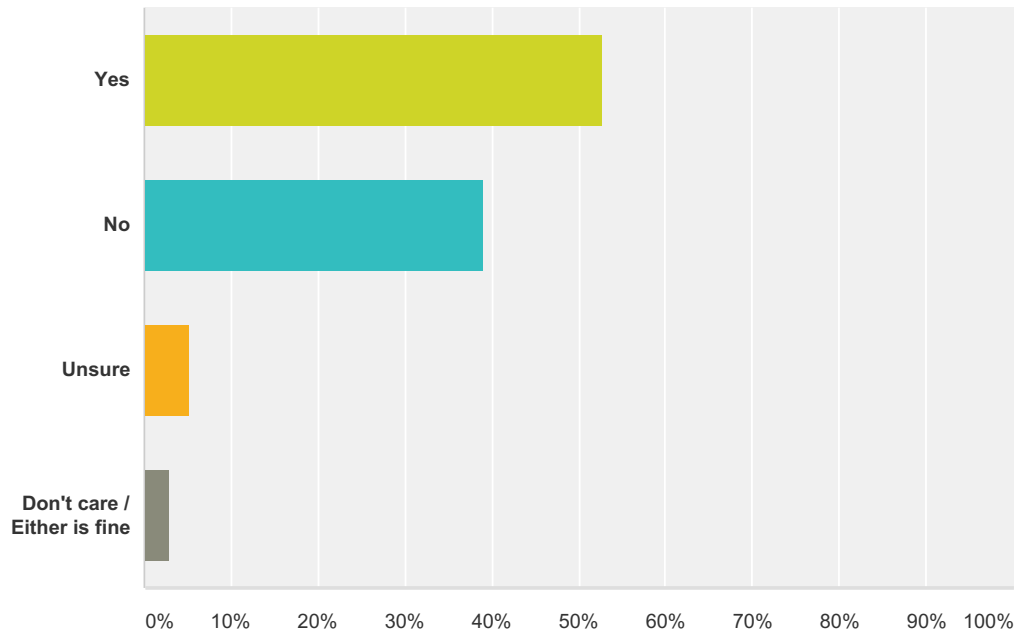

Q9 Should UAPD support soda taxes and other laws aimed at curbing consumption of sugary drinks?

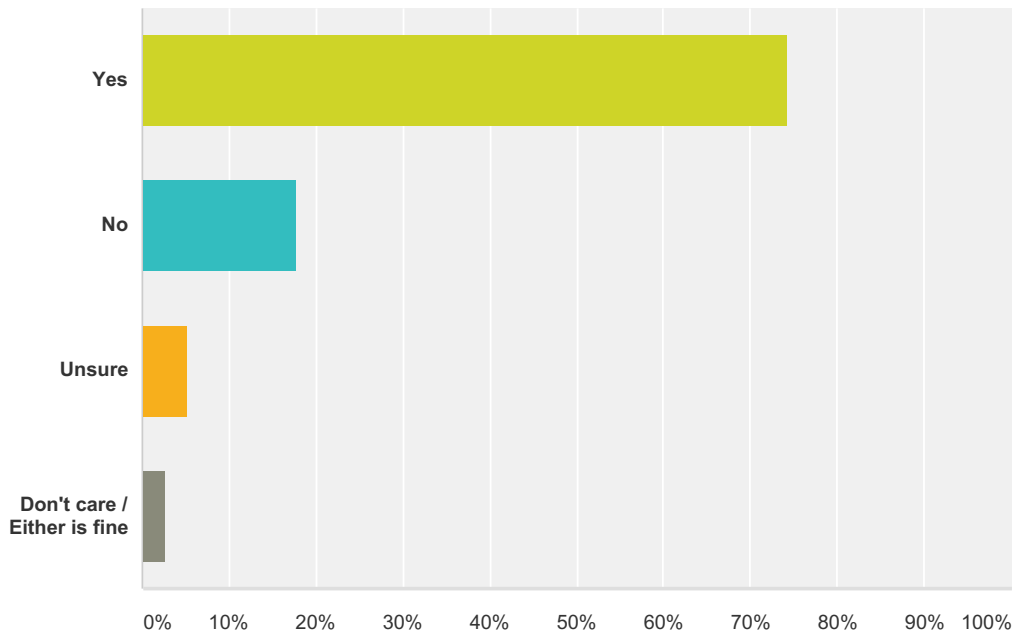

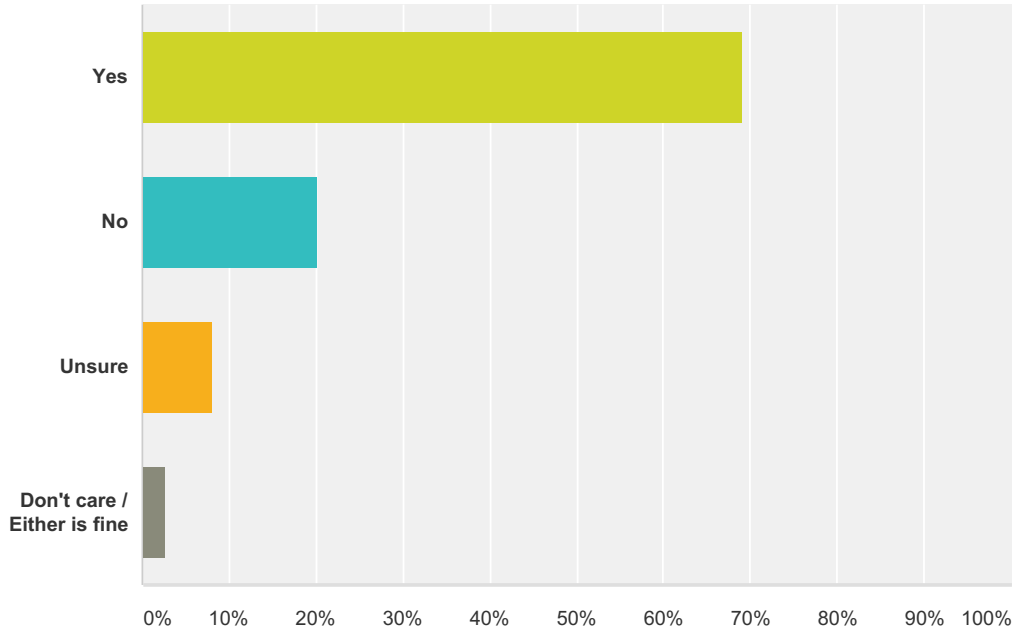

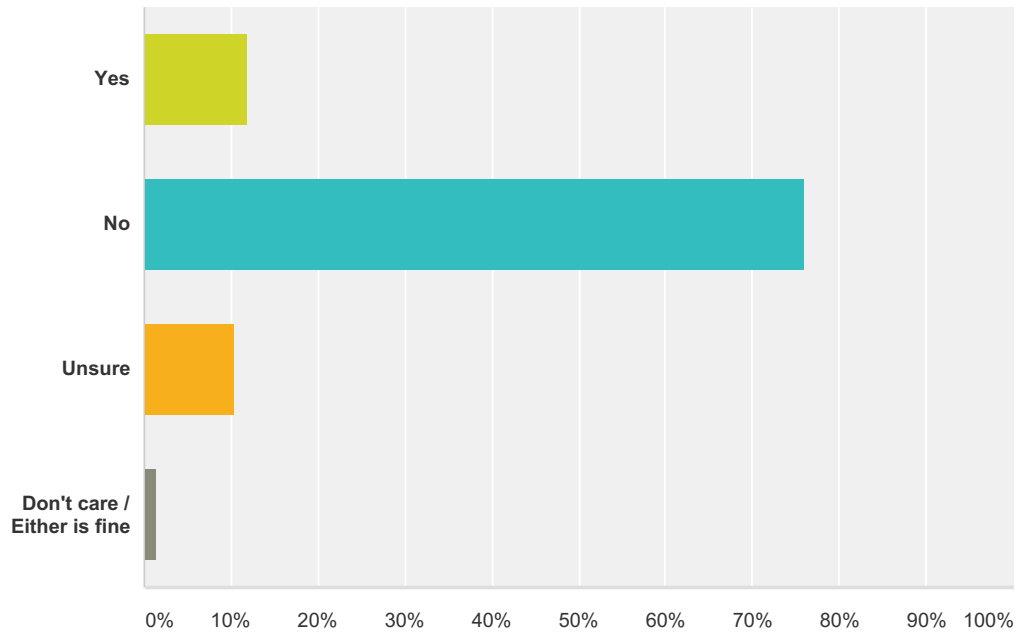

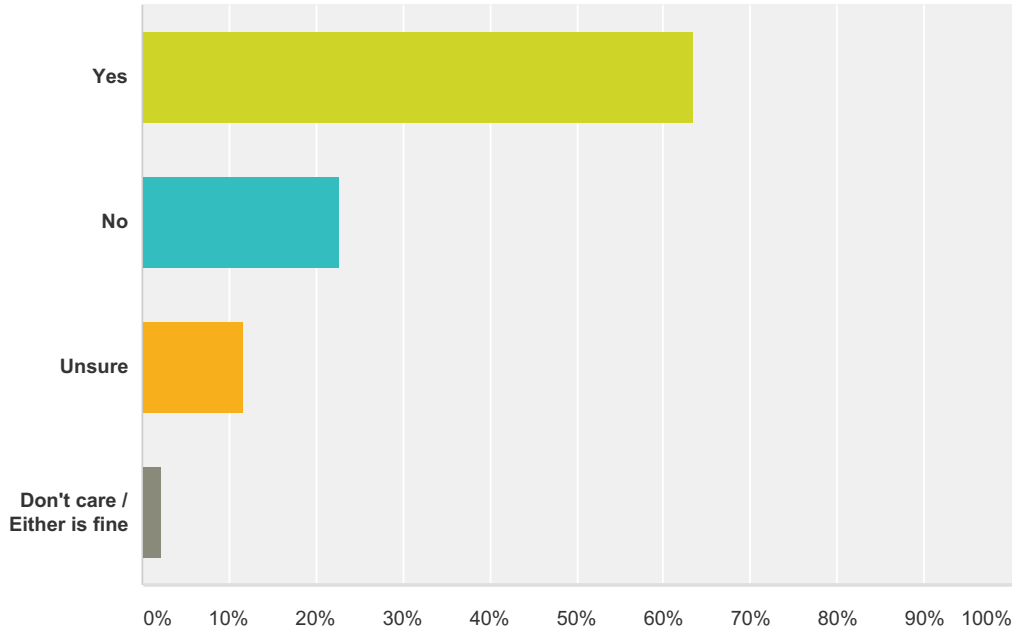

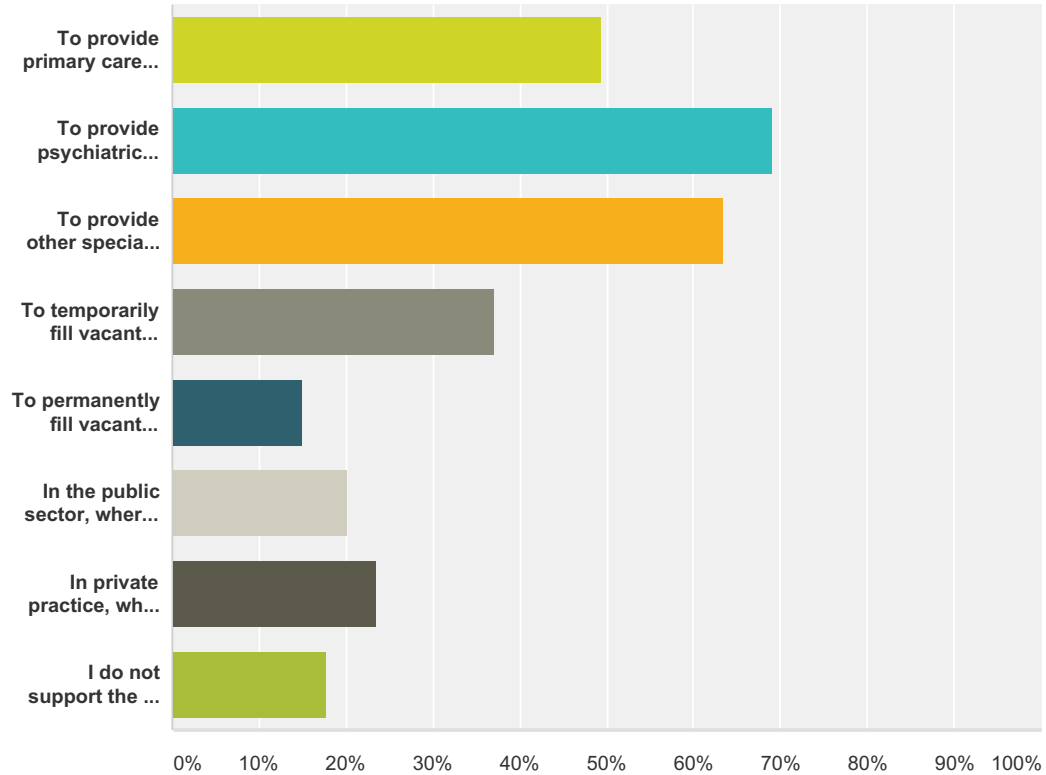
