- Robert Brody, M.D., Clinical Professor of Medicine and Family & Community Medicine, UCSF, will speak on physician-hastened death.
- Brian Lee, M.D., Co-Director, Division of Infectious Diseases, Director, Antimicrobial Stewardship Program, UCSF Benioff Children's Hospital Oakland, will talk about the importance of antibiotic stewardship.
